DEADLINE FOR ABSTRACTS: THURSDAY 1ST SEPTEMBER 2016

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

The abstract should be laid out as follows:

- Title of paper (capitals, bold).
- Name of author(s), present job title, qualifications, address of the presenter/s.
- Maximum length of abstracts one side of an A4 sheet (up to 150 words), including
- any references.
- Please use Times New Roman, size 12 font, 1.5 spacing.
- Use the Harvard referencing System, if applicable.

GUIDELINES REGARDING POSTER PRESENTATION

- Poster size – recommendation Maximum poster size of (A0 size i.e. 1,118 x 840mm maximum (portrait), please ensure you bring your own adhesive (Velcro) to attach your poster.
- Posters can be set up the morning of the conference (preferably prior to 8.45 am) and removed after 16.00 hrs.
- Presentation of prize for best poster is at the end of the last oral session.

SHARING SUCCESSFUL PRACTICES

- Please indicate with your abstract submission if you DO NOT want to be considered for presentation during this session.
- This session will be shared between the best three submissions and will involve a short 10-15minute presentation on your poster including a brief questions and answers session.
- You can choose to present with one other person on your poster, but no more than 2 people may present.
- All presenters will be supported by a chairperson for the session.
