### Course Outline

The foundation module in anaesthesia/recovery room care for nurses and midwives will commence in September 2018. The module has been developed collaboratively by School of Nursing and Midwifery TCD, the College of Anaesthetists Ireland and the National Clinical Programme for Anaesthesia.

### Structure and Delivery

The module will be delivered three times a year. The module will start in September each year. Each intake requires compulsory attendance at two study days, one day in the classroom and one day attending practical workshops. Additional course material is available online.

### The course assessment has three components:

1. 100% attendance at both study days
2. Submission of a written case study (1,500 words)
3. Submission of a continuous assessment of practice document

### Location

Classes will be delivered in the College of Anaesthetists Ireland, 22 Merrion Square N, Dublin 2.

### Entry Requirements

#### The criteria for admission are:

- current registration on the live register held by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland
- currently working in anaesthesia/recovery room
- HSE employees require a letter of support from the Director of Nursing/Midwifery confirming support to attend and the availability of a clinical mentor in practice
